"The Mask You Live In" Screening

Please join Malcolm X and Washington PTAs on Wednesday, March 15th at 5:30pm at Washington Elementary for a screening of "The Mask You Live In," a documentary film about how we raise boys in America. This film looks at the damaging effects of our culture's narrow definition of masculinity. Pressured by the media, their peer group, and even the adults in their lives, the boys and men in the film confront messages encouraging them to disconnect from their emotions, devalue authentic friendships, objectify and degrade women, and resolve conflicts through violence. These gender stereotypes interconnect with race, class, and circumstance, creating a maze of identity issues boys and young men must navigate to become "real" men. After the screening, a 30-minute discussion will be led by the film's producer, Washington parent Jessica Anthony, and Ashanti Branch, founder of the Ever Forward Club and a subject in the film.
