

2nd and 4th Tuesdays of the month, 2:30 – 4pm



1, 30-minute

36 weeks focusing
on choral music
(TK-3rd) and
instrumental
music (4th/5th)



DANCE

1, 30-minute class/week for 36 weeks (TK/K)

1, 45-minute class/week for 12 weeks (1st–5th)



For all grades, Dance is integrated into PE instruction.

DRAMA

2, 30-minute classes/week for 12 weeks (TK/K)

2, 45-minute classes/week for 12 weeks (1st-5th)



VISUAL ARTS

1, 45-minute class/month for 36 weeks (K)

1, 45-minute class/week for 36 weeks (1st–3rd)

1, 45-minute class/week for 18 weeks (4th/5th)

In TK, Art is led by the classroom teacher. In 4th/5th, it is co-taught w/ the classroom teacher.


